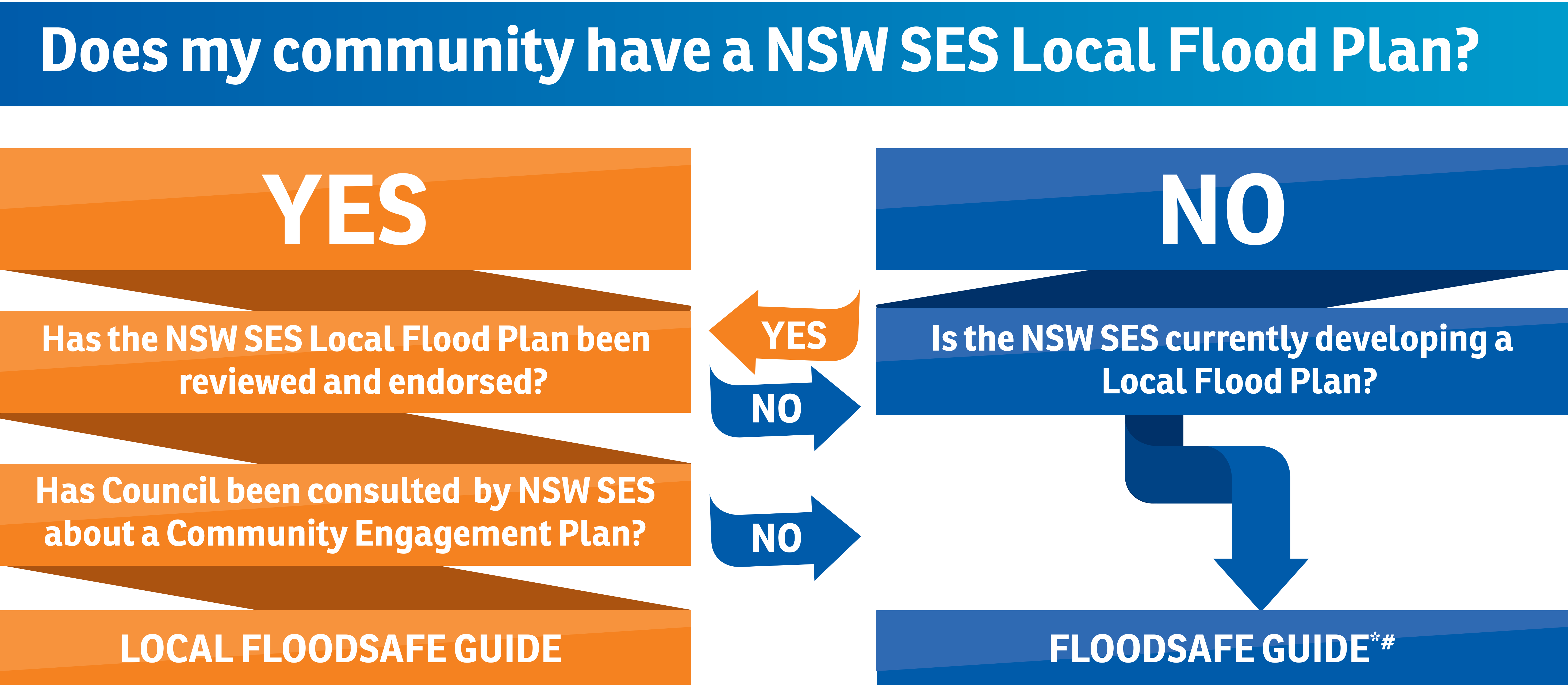


The NSW SES can help you produce a FloodSafe Guide for your community.
