FLOODSAFE - A message from the State Emergency Service (SES)

Floodwaters are not safe

Floodwaters can kill

Never drive, ride, walk or play in floodwaters

Take important papers, photos and identification with you when you evacuate

Tell friends and neighbours in area about the flood danger

Floodwaters can have waste, chemicals and dirty water in them

Floodwaters could damage roads

Flooding can last for many days or weeks, be prepared for potential isolation

Watch for snakes, spiders and wildlife

Go to higher, safe dry areas if advised by emergency services

Flood and Storm Emergency Assistance call 132 500

Life threatening Emergency call 000

Prepare a home emergency plan

Stay tuned to radio for emergency warnings

Prepare an emergency kit with:

- Important papers
- Battery powered radio
- First aid kit
- Torch
