

# NSW SES Warnings

## A multi-hazard, three-tiered warning system



### Advice

An incident has started. Stay up to date as the situation changes.



#### ACTION STATEMENTS

Stay informed  
Monitor conditions

Reduced threat:  
return with caution



### Watch and Act

Conditions are changing and you need to start taking action now to protect you and your family.



#### ACTION STATEMENTS

Do not enter floodwater  
Prepare to evacuate

Prepare to isolate  
Avoid the area



### Emergency Warning

You may be in danger and need to take action immediately.



#### ACTION STATEMENTS

Evacuate now / Evacuate before [time]

Shelter now

Move to higher ground



# Three Warning Components



## Location + Hazard

The location and the type of hazard impacting the community (e.g. Smithtown flooding).



## Action Statement

An action statement/s to guide protective action by the community, evolving as the warning levels increase in severity (eg 'stay informed').



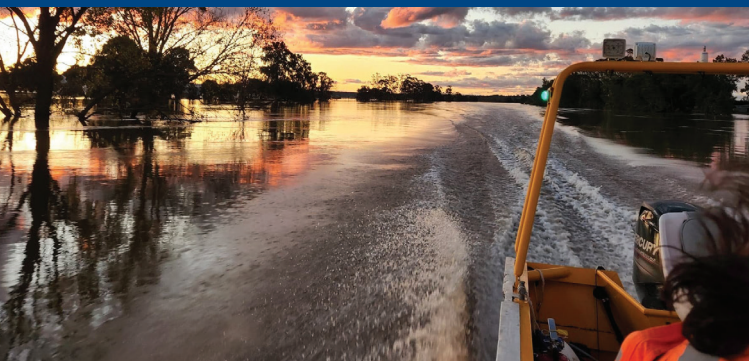
## Warning Level

The severity of the natural hazard event and the consequences on the community.

### FOR EXAMPLE:

**Smithtown East Flooding** - Prepare to Evacuate - **Watch and Act**

**Arkville North Flooding** - Evacuate Now - **Emergency Warning**
