From 30 September 2022, the NSW SES will be adopting the Australian Warning System to provide a nationally consistent approach to warnings prior to the impact of severe weather events. Our new warnings have clear action statements to better support communities make safe decisions and take action.

A multi-hazard, three-tiered warning system

Stay up to date in case the situation changes.

Stay informed
Monitor conditions
Reduced threat:
return with caution



Watch and Act

Conditions are changing and
you need to start taking
action now to protect you

ACTION STATEMENTS

Do not enter floodwater
Prepare to evacuate
Prepare to isolate
Avoid the area



Emergency Warning

You may be in danger and
need to take action
immediately.



ACTION STATEMENTS

Evacuate now /
Evacuate before [time]
Shelter now
Move to higher ground
